Bring us closer to you.

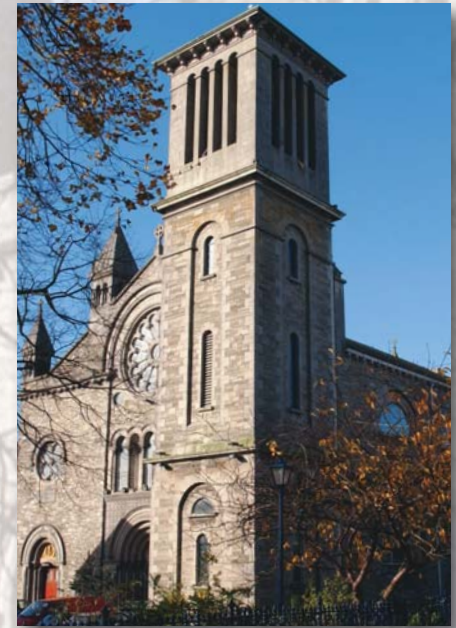
